BRIEF HISTORY

In 1950 John Pozzobon, a member of the Schoenstatt Movement in Santa Maria Brazil received a picture of the Mother Thrice Admirable of Schoenstatt. It was suggested to him that he take this large image of the Mother Thrice Admirable of Schoenstatt framed in the shape of the Schoenstatt Shrine into the homes of many people.

By accepting this holy task and mission John Pozzobon took the words of Schoenstatt's Founder Fr Joseph Kentenich to heart by bringing the MTA to people so that from the Shrine she could distribute many graces.

For thirty five years John took the MTA on pilgrimage, walking more than 137,000 kilometres and brought the picture of grace to families, schools; prisons and hospitals.

It is from here that the Schoenstatt Pilgrim Mother Apostolate took its form.
