

PILGRIM MOTHER APOSTOLATE

HOW CAN I TAKE PART?

1. Gather a **group of people** (minimum 6-7) who are willing to commit themselves to welcoming the **Schoenstatt Pilgrim Mother Shrine** into their home. The framed picture of the Mother Thrice Admirable of Schoenstatt in the shape of a wooden Shrine travels from member to member during the course of one month.
2. A **Pilgrim Mother Coordinator** who is responsible for the Pilgrim Mother Shrine is nominated.

4. Each member of the group is asked to prepare a **place of honour** for the Pilgrim Mother Shrine in their home or work place.
5. All who pray in front of the Pilgrim Mother Shrine, honour our Mother Thrice Admirable – as Mother of God, Mother of the Redeemer, Mother of the Redeemed, that is, all of us, as the people of God. During Mary's visit, personal or family prayer is encouraged. Many like to pray the rosary, entrusting their petitions to Mary's care and bringing their gratitude, realising Mary's blessings and intercession. Each visit of the Pilgrim Mother Shrine would probably be two to four days a month, depending on the size of the group.
6. The Pilgrim Mother Coordinator helps ensure the overall safe travelling of the Pilgrim Mother Shrine. However, every member, whenever possible, cooperates in helping to pass on the Pilgrim Mother Shrine to the next person on the list.
7. During the year there are opportunities for co-ordinators and group members to meet locally or at the Schoenstatt Shrine at Mount Richon.
