

THE PILGRIM MOTHER APOSTOLATE IN WA

From the original Schoenstatt Shrine in Germany, the Pilgrim Mother Apostolate (PMA) has grown to more than 200 daughter Shrines all over the world. The Pilgrim Mother Shrine bears the image of the Mother Thrice Admirable. It is made in the form of a wooden Shrine and is therefore a miniature Shrine. From the Pilgrim Mother Shrines real graces flow as it would from all Schoenstatt Shrines.

In late 1986, the PMA in WA began from the Shrine at Riverton Parish where the Schoenstatt Sisters of Mary worked. From here the PMA steadily grew and in November 1991 the Shrine in Armadale was blessed. From the Shrine in Armadale 85 Pilgrim Mother Shrines travel the regions of Perth, from Geraldton to Albany.
